Our concerns regarding this project are as follows:

1) If the amount of trees that are proposed to be taken down on that hillside, will that compromise the hillside in terms of rain, landslides, mudslides?

2) As this end of Chesham is a private road, we have to maintain the road and all costs. It is a big project and requires big trucks to come down this narrow street and we are concerned about it getting ripped up and having to endure those costs.

3) As a narrow street which really only fits one car at a time, we have issues with the UPS & Fed Ex trucks blocking the road. It will be exacerbated with the big trucks that are used to clear land and bring in construction materials.

4) We live on this street because of its charm and the tree canopy over the street. This could be also jeopardized by those big trucks.

5) What is the estimate of time for this project? Are you going to tell me that the 15+ homeowners who actually "own" the street and use it for parking will be impacted for a year or possible two?
